4.2.12 Shri Raghunath Kirti Campus, Devprayag, Uttarakhand

1. Introduction

Shri Raghunatha Kirti Adarsha Sanskrit Mahavidylaya (Estd.1908), Devaprayaga, Uttarakhand was taken over by Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan on 16th June, 2016 as its 13th constituent Campus. The campus has been named after the famous ancient deity Shri Raghunathaji shrine in the ancient Raghunatha temple constructed in the Katyuri style of Katyuri dynasty of the mountains on the holy confluence of two important mythological rivers, namely, Bhagirathi and Alaknanda from where exactly the river Ganga is originated.

Because of this cultural, spiritual and educational background, the campus was inaugurated here on 16.06.16. The former Sanskrit Mahavidylaya has donated its premises with a vast land measuring 3.443 hectares and simultaneously the Govt. of Uttarakhand has also allotted some adjourned portion of land measuring 9.228 hectares. Now the campus has total land of 23 acres. The land with the complete approved lay-out plan has been handed over to CPWD (Shrinagar Branch) for the construction of the campus building The first Foundion stone was laid by the honourable Governor of Uttarakhand Dr. K.K.Paul on 06.05.2017 whereas the Second Foundation stone was laid by Dr. Satyapal Singh, the honourable state Minister of Higher Education, Ministry of HRD, Govt. Of India on 08.11.2017. The construction of all the required blocks including Academic, Administrative and residential (Hostel for Boys and Girls both, Guest House and several types of Staff Quarters) along with Library hall, Auditorium and Stadium (play ground) etc. are in progress and heading towards completion.

So far as the geographical, historical, cultural, mythological and educational status is concerned, Devaprayaga comes in the state of Uttarakhanda, popularly and culturally known as Devabhumi or the divine land.

2. Regular Courses Offered

The newly established campus now functions with six departments where traditional subjects like Vyakarana, Jyotisha, Sahitya, Veda, Vedanta and Nyaya are being taught along with the modern Subjects like Hindi, English, History, computer science etc. (up to graduation or Shastri level). Around hundred students are admitted to following different classes:

- Prak Shastri (Intermediate)
- Shastri (B.A.)
- Acharya (M.A.)

Vidyavaridhi (Ph.D.): The campus is also committed to offer research programmes for the award of Vidyavaridhi (Ph.D.) degree of Centeral Sanskrit University. At present seven research students are enrolled in the campus for their Ph.D. works.

Center of Distance Education Mukta-Swadhyayapeetha

Muktswadhyaypeetham under the Central Sanskrit University is always engaged in promotion of Sanskrit Language through distance education, for which self-study centres have established in all the Campuses of University. Establishment of self-study centre in Shri Raghunath Kirti Campus has been done in 2020-21 session, under which the bridge courses for astrology, literature and vyakarna and full courses have been offered from prak-shastri to acharya respectively. In addition, certificate course in Sanskrit journalism, certificate courses in Pali and Praakrit languages have also been started, in which Sanskrit students are studying. The responsibility of its coordination has been given to Dr. Anil Kumar. Tourism and Ayurveda regarding courses are also planned to be included in future.
